



To slow the spread of coronavirus and protect our community members' health, Scappoose Public Library is making thoughtful decisions to close the library beginning Monday, March 16. The Library will continue to accept books and materials returns in the book drop located outside. As a reminder, online services will still be available, such as e-books and e-audio books. In addition, overdue fees will not be charged during this closed period. Staff will be at the library 10-6 Monday through Friday during this period to answer phones. Check our website or Facebook page for updates. We will re-evaluate the situation in our county the week of March 23rd and decide whether to reopen, but we will not reopen before March 25. We have extended due dates on all materials due after March 14 to April 18.
